

**LIBERTY NOTES***By Kevin L. Jamison*

It is a good day for Liberty.

The panel discussion last month the Moms Demand representatives scorned the idea of armed teachers. They quoted with approval a teacher who said that under no circumstances could she shoot a student. I can understand pacifists. I do not understand teachers who will not defend my children. One of the Moms Demand representatives said that if she found a teacher who was armed she would take her child out of the school district. I take the opposite view. If a teacher will not protect my child from fire, injury or attack I am getting my kid out of that class. They kept stressing that some of their members owned guns. There may be some self-hating gun owners out there. They claim five million members. They stressed that they came from hunting families; nice stories about eating deer meat. I do not hunt. I do not eat deer meat. I am into guns for self-defense and do not want to eat the results.

I listened to an audiobook of "The Free State of Jones;" a true story. There is a movie taken from the book. The book tells a number of stories. The main character is a Confederate veteran of some very nasty battles including Vicksburg. That was when he said "To heck with this." He would not fight for the Confederacy but he organized a group to fight the Confederacy. His county, Jones Mississippi, seceded from the Confederacy which did not extend its secessionist philosophy to counties and individuals. His shotgun militia protected his home county until the end of the war. A third story is Reconstruction, in which Southern "Rifle Clubs" defied being reconstructed until the federal government got tired of the attempt. It seems that the presidential election was tied in the Electoral College until the South made a deal to end reconstruction in exchange for its votes. The fourth story concerns protecting his friends from the unreconstructed Confederates, again with his old shotgun militia.

The book goes off onto tangents. In one tangent Union troops ask Confederate prisoners why they fight. They said it was because the Union was going to make their sisters marry Negroes. I have met Southern women. I can't see how they could be made to do anything they don't want to do

The local tabloid ran a review of Jennifer Garner's new movie "Peppermint." This movie concerns a mother whose husband and daughter are murdered by gangsters. The killers are released by a corrupt judge. She sets out to take revenge on the gangsters. The reviewer complains that Ms Garner's character "doesn't think big enough. The low-level gangsters aren't her enemy. Her true enemy is a system of income inequality driven by hyper-capitalism." This part of the review was placed in large block type next to Jennifer Garner's photo. I remember a conservative editor who said the best place to put propaganda is in movie reviews. He was right. The trick is to get conservative reviews into the local tabloid.

Plastic guns are again in the courts. The designer of a plastic gun which can be made on a 3-d printer made a deal with the government allowing him to give away his plans. The usual suspects had a fit and a court issued an order restraining him from giving away the plans. He then started selling them. The order had not envisioned this. The usual suspects had greater fits and the matter is tied up in the courts.

The 3-d printers capable of making these guns are very expensive.

The designer has new trouble. He has been accused of sexual assault and is now in jail. His company has been taken over by a partner. The future relies on many things; not least of which is the election.

The plastic gun fires a single .380 cartridge. Some samples blow up when fired. It is against the law to make or possess a plastic gun which cannot be detected by x-ray or metal detector. It is not against the law to possess the plans to make such a gun, only to make one.

A person may make a gun for personal use. The maker must do all the work himself. One machinist programmed a computer to machine a gun receiver. The person who commissioned the gun then pushed the button to start the process. Everyone was convicted of illegal manufacture. The gun can only be made for personal use not for sale. I have not researched inheritance. The gun, made of steel or plastic, must have the maker's name, city and state of manufacture. It must also have a number that is unique to that gun and not on any other zip gun.

In a "Bones" episode an attorney is in an absolute honesty club. The cast makes great fun of this, making jokes about the impossibility of a lawyer telling the truth. I must rise to defend my profession. A lawyer may be selective in what truth is told. He must tell the truth. Not telling the truth is likely to come out. One of my clients gave me forged documents. The opposing attorney caught the forgery and that was the end of the case. That client has called to hire me for other cases. I declined. An important part of the process is HOW to tell the truth. In the immortal words of John Wayne "Talk low. Talk Slow. And don't talk too much."

Since 1971 I have worn a POW/MIA bracelet for Lt. James Plowman, a Navy pilot lost over North Viet Nam 24, March 1967. I recently discovered that his remains had been found and identified. He's home. My current bracelet is the third copy I've had. I managed to break the other two. The current bracelet has rubbed against my shirt sleeve for so long that the engraving is almost illegible. It gives me trouble going through metal detectors. The original idea was to wear them until the missing came home. I am reluctant to take it off. There are other members of the services still missing. I'll have to think on it. There is time.

Larry, and great for his students. We may have a crop of criminal justice students coming up who actually understand the concept of the operation. We hope that he will favor us with an article from time to time.

Jason Kander has stepped out of the race for mayor of Kansas City. He says that he has PTSD from his tour in Afghanistan. He did three months in the war but it does not take long to trigger PTSD. A single incident can do it. There was a case at Ft. Bragg. A paratrooper passed out frequently and that was thought to be a problem. It turns out that he passed out only at a certain location, where he had been mugged. Everyone I have represented who has killed in self-defense has suffered from PTSD to a greater or lesser extent and a greater or lesser amount of time. There is no easy cure but it provides a new defense. No one would get into a shooting, knowing PTSD awaited him, if there was any alternative.

I have been reading an article in Recoil magazine about the gun laws in Afghanistan. They have laws restricting weapons possession in Afghanistan and a fat lot of good it has done them. We shall overcome.

PRESIDENT'S CORNER

DO YOU MATTER?

As I write this Judge Kavanaugh has been confirmed as the newest Justice of the Supreme Court. The vote was 50 to 48. This is very close. The result is that we now have a 5-4 majority on the Supreme Court. Of course that is what we had when Justice Kennedy retired at the beginning of the summer. Of course, Justice Kavanaugh will be a stronger vote for gun owners than Justice Kennedy.

Justice Kavanaugh was accused of not having a "judicial temperament." At the hearing he vigorously denied being a sex molester and rapist. The Democratic committee members accused him of being "partisan." He was on his own side and by them that is partisan. Any case coming before him will not be personal to him.

A local columnist declared that if Dr. Ford was sincere in her accusation, then the Judge must be guilty. This is wrong. There have been a number of recorded cases in which a person sincerely claimed to have been raped or abused, but investigation proved that the claim was not possible. False memory is a recognized problem. Dr. Ford could be telling the truth as she remembered it, and be wrong.

The Democrats threaten to impeach the new Justice. This requires that they get a majority in the house and senate.

As I write this I am also watching a DVD of "All the King's Men." It is a very thinly veiled account of the beginning of the Long dynasty in Louisiana. At one point the populist candidate tells his audience "If you don't vote, you don't matter." This is true. You may be completely right on the issues of our time. You may be frustrated at the lack of progress. You may believe the system is fixed. If you don't vote, you don't matter. If you don't vote you don't get to complain. The fewer people who vote, the easier to cook the results.

Poll: Majority of Americans Oppose 'Assault Rifles' Ban

A Gallup poll released October 19 shows that a majority of Americans oppose passing a ban on "assault rifles." According to the poll, 40 percent of Americans support such a ban but 57 percent oppose it. Gallup notes that the 40 percent "support for an assault rifles ban is below the historical average of 47%."

The numbers are news because they invert years of alleged surveys which indicated massive support for such a ban. For instance:

67 [...] percent for a nationwide ban on the sale of assault weapons (Quinnipiac poll)

2/22/2018: [70% of Americans want stricter assault weapon laws — more than ever before](#)

The nationwide average of **70%** is even higher than the 67% **that want to ban assault weapons** and the 66% that wanted tougher gun laws in general in a recent Quinnipiac University poll. Those figures are the highest ever in the 10-year history of the poll. (MSN poll)

And yet, here we are in October 2018:

[Gallup: In U.S., Support for Assault Weapons Ban at Record Low](#)

In Gallup's 2016 Crime poll, conducted Oct. 5-9, opposition now exceeds support by 25 percentage points, 61% to 36%.

"Damn it, Swift! Any time the numbers are pro-RKBA, you're supposed to flip the chart over before releasing it."

This may be the closest-to-honest poll released by Gallup in years, if not decades. I never believed the previous counter-polls because they never approached the reality expressed in actual popular votes, referendums and initiatives. This new Gallup poll comes closer to matching real-world voting by the people.

People "vote" in other ways, as well. Earlier this year, [California reclassified crippled "bullet-button" rifles as "assault weapons" and required they be registered.](#) It's been estimated that only **three percent (3%)** were actually registered.

One might expect that registration compliance rate to be a little higher if even 36% percent of folks think they should be banned.

Gallup seems to have stumbled up, and accidentally released, the partial truth of majority opposition to confiscation schemes. But they still haven't grasped the magnitude of opposition.

Three percent. Compliance. Consider that California laws essentially required every lawful gun owner to be licensed (thus registered), and all firearms sales to be recorded. 97% of registered owners with registered suddenly-assault-weapons blew them off this year. In California.

"More than ever I admire those celebrities who steadfastly resist the temptation (or the hectoring) to talk politics. There are still some of them, including Bruno Mars, Mark Wahlberg, Reba McEntire, and Josh Duhamel. They follow in the footsteps of one of the greatest entertainers in American history. At the peak of his long career, Elvis Presley's influence on popular culture was unparalleled, but about politics he would say nothing. A classic illustration occurred during a pre-concert press conference at Madison Square Garden in 1972. It was at the height of the antiwar movement, and Presley, an Army veteran, was asked for his thoughts on the Vietnam War protests. 'Honey, I'd just as soon keep my own personal views about that to myself,' he answered modestly. 'I'm just an entertainer and I'd rather not say.' Faced with the pressure to get political, Elvis knew how to shake it off. Would that could still be said about Taylor Swift."
