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**LIBERTY NOTES***By Kevin L. Jamison*

It is a good day for Liberty.

The US Concealed Carry Association, publishers of Concealed Carry Magazine, will have their annual concealed carry expo in Kansas City Missouri 20-22 March, 2020. It will be held at the KCI expo center where the RK gun show is held. There will be seminars, classes, exhibits of all manner of self-defense equipment and accessories.

Rally Day has been changed to 7 April, 2020 still in the Capital Building in Jefferson City. A great many anti rights bills have been filed and it will take a good showing just to maintain our existing rights. To expand our rights will take a great showing.

After a massive guns rights rally the Virginia legislature went ahead and passed anti-gun rights bills. Virginia shooters had a higher hill to climb than we do. They had a legislature that was rolling down hill on them. We have a legislature that is standing still. To prevent it from rolling down hill on us requires a certain degree of effort. It requires extra effort because the usual suspects are on the other side pushing. To make progress pushing the legislature further up the hill we will need a great deal more effort. We need people to show up. We need them to write their legislators and the governor. There is no substitute for voters paying attention.

A woman in Alabama killed her rapist. She was charged with murder. She asked for a hearing to dismiss the charge on a showing of self-defense. Missouri has a similar law. Her motion to dismiss was denied. The judge was concerned that her statements were inconsistent and that she had not escaped from her rapist when an opportunity seemed to appear. This could be a result of stress and fear. It shows the danger of making statements. Multiple statements will be compared, and minor inconsistencies will be exaggerated. I am reluctant to ask for these dismissal hearings. To have a chance at winning it is necessary to parade all of your evidence before the prosecution. If you lose the motion, the prosecution knows your defense. Judges are reluctant to dispose of cases. If they leave it to the jury, they cannot be criticized.

Shark attacks have dropped worldwide, except in the United States. There are those who would impeach President Trump on such evidence. It is a sign that some things happen on a random basis with little or no reason. People take a fluctuation in crime as significant. They attach it to something involving guns. To be meaningful it must take into account a multitude of facts. The percentage of 15 to 25-year-old males in the population is the first question. The drug competition in the area often leads to murder.

A man in Overland Park tried to buy a gun. He seems to have appeared erratic at the gun shop and was denied the sale. Very Good. This may have prevented a fatal shooting. His sister was strangled to death.

A conservative student at Lake Superior State University in Michigan posted a picture on Snapchat of himself with his AR-15. He captioned the picture "This ought to make the snowflakes melt . . ." One of the members of his group showed it to a leftist student. That was all it took. He was charged with making a terrorist threat. This shows how innocent comments can be misinterpreted, perhaps deliberately. The Founding Fathers treasured the right of free speech. They also valued the right to remain silent. Our ancestors fought and died for the right to remain silent. It would be unpatriotic not to use it.

A man who was shot by a mass killer is suing his synagogue for failure to take reasonable care. I will leave the merits of the suit to others. Many houses of worship are establishing defensive teams because many houses of worship are being attacked. They will continue to be attacked as long as they are perceived as soft targets. There have been magazine articles on the subject and books have devoted sections to the subject. Several churches have asked my opinion of the legality of defensive teams. Of course they are legal. They should not be necessary but churches are united in the belief that there is evil in the world. Defense teams are necessary.

The Kansas City police no longer give written Miranda warnings to suspects. They only give verbal warnings. This changes nothing. Talking to professional questioners without a professional to intercede is stupid.

The terrorist attack on London Bridge a few months ago could have been much worse. It did not become much worse because Britons fought back. The terrorist only had knives and Britons were able to fight back with bottles and chairs. In America we have a better chance. Close quarters battle with a terrorist anxious to die is by no means an equal battle. A gun is the great equalizer. Criminals and terrorists do not expect resistance. When they encounter it they are unprepared; they flee, surrender or commit suicide.

I have seen a number of cases in which a child finds a gun and there is a tragedy. The parent is then charged with endangering the welfare of a child. Some of the circumstances are drug induced gross negligence. In one case a father was charged because he did not lock the gun up. He was in the process of locking the gun up when his child snatched up the gun and fired it. This is likely to create a body of experience which presumes that having a gun and a child is endangerment. We must be very careful. We cannot help the drug addicts in our society endangering their children. We have to stress that we teach gun safety. We are the ones taking action to save children. A judge sentenced a man to probation on the condition that he attend a gun safety course. He was appalled to discover that none of so called "gun safety" groups had such a course. Only the NRA sponsors such classes.

We are still early in the election season. At this time we do not know who the democratic presidential nominee will be. There is an argument that any of the contenders could get the nod. It makes no difference to us. The democratic contenders all want to violate our rights.

### The Oklahoma senator standing up to gun confiscation

I know I've earned the reputation for being "that guy" that rips all politicians for being bad on issues from spending to the Second Amendment. It sometimes feels like I'm on island, but with more and more people starting to realize their elected officials aren't really their friends, I can breathe a sigh of relief. At least, I can sleep knowing my rants are finally being accepted by normal people. \*chuckles\* Even better news is now some elected officials are starting to get a clue about what's going on.

Let's look at the case of Oklahoma. State Senator Nathan Dahm has been one of the most effective pro-liberty elected officials in the past few years. I've actually gotten to meet him on separate occasions, and I have been thoroughly impressed by his initiative. He was the primary champion for Constitutional Carry in Oklahoma and helped get it passed last year, thus cementing Oklahoma as one of the more pro-gun states in the country. He is now pushing the envelope yet again by introducing a bill that would prohibit local city and county governments from passing red flag gun confiscations orders.

Red flag laws are the gun control flavor of the week. These laws allow acquaintances, relatives, or police to get a court order to confiscate a person's firearms simply if they're suspected to be a threat to themselves or others. But there's a catch..... it's all done without due process! You know, that pesky safeguard that separates America from the rest of the world. Thankfully, Oklahoma doesn't have this gun control abomination on the books.

Unlike his colleagues, Dahm goes the extra mile to fight for his constituent's liberties. The bill he's pushing makes it a felony for someone to assist in the enforcement of red flag orders. He's looking in the long-term (something no one does these days) and perceives possible threats of gun control tyranny potentially going down in the next decade or so. Senator Dahm is making sure to have all bases covered.

Kansas is also pursuing a similar bill, which you can find out about in my post for *The Advocates for Self-Government*.

P.S. State Senators like Dahm are more of the exception rather than the rule.

Since the federal government has remained aloof to the concerns of gun owners for decades, states will have to pick up the slack. But even those politicians can't do this alone. In fact, most of them won't go out of their way to take up pro-gun causes like Senator Dahm did. They'll need pressure from below.

That's where people like you come in. There's no reason to be complaining about the status quo when we have so much information and tools at our disposal in order to fight back. In fact, I've made my little contribution to this fight by creating a guide on gun control myths. 

Each month I sit in front of a blank screen and try to summarize the good and bad of our movement. Events, rage or rejoicing inspire words. Sometimes nothing has happened.

Despite the hubris surrounding the impeachment hearing February is much the same as January. There are still anti-gun rights bills in the legislature. There are still pro-gun rights. Which bills will pass depends on how much interest voters demonstrate. Attendance at the 7 April, 2020 Rally is critical. Letters and postcards are simple and effective. Personal visits are best.

There has been a seemingly minor possibly major event. Virginia's legislature sent a perfect horror of an anti-gun rights bill to Virginia's Senate. A senate committee agreed to put the perfect horror on hold until the 2021 session of the legislature. The perfect horror was thought to be a done deal and the delay is significant by itself. It is more significant that it is put off past the 2020 election. The 2018 election showed a low voter turnout in Virginia. The 2020 election gives the opportunity to elect a few pro-gun rights legislators. A few legislators may not vote down the perfect horror. They can delay the bill's progress, perhaps beyond the following election. If the usual suspects are prevented from passing their perfect horror in Virginia, that makes it less likely to come to Missouri.

This doesn't mean that we don't have threats in Missouri. We will continue to have threats in Missouri. The usual suspects have not advanced these threats in thirty years because we have come out to oppose them. They are better organized and better financed today. But there are more of us.

### Florida's 'Red Flag' Applied Over 3,500 Times in Just Two Years


Two years have passed since a mentally unstable young man shot and killed 17 people at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School in Parkland, Florida. The atrocity sparked a massive campaign by gun-control advocates pressing for more laws limiting Americans' Second Amendment rights. Within three weeks of the school attack, Florida's legislature passed several new firearms regulations, including a bipartisan "red flag" bill that was signed into law by then-Gov. Rick Scott, a Republican.

Since the law's implementation, it has been used more than 3,500 times to temporarily confiscate people's firearms, and, the Associated Press reports, "the pace accelerat[ed] during the last half of 2019." The question remains: Has the law demonstrably proven to effectively prevent people from harming themselves or others? Predictably, answers vary depending on who is asked.

On the one hand, Pinellas County Sheriff Bob Gualtieri asserts, "We have needed this law for decades." On the other hand, sheriffs from several other Florida counties — who have never issued red-flag orders — noted that the reason was that they simply hadn't needed them.

The crux of the problem with red-flag laws is the violation of constitutional protections for due process. For example, with Florida's law, if a civil court issues a confiscation order, it's up to the defendant to not only prove his innocence but also to provide for his own counsel. As the AP notes, "Others say it discriminates against the poor: Because the hearing with a judge is not a criminal proceeding, low-income defendants aren't provided with a free lawyer."

Following the red-flag confiscation of firearms, a hearing is held within two weeks wherein a judge decides if the person's firearms will be withheld for a year. Once again, no actual law has been broken by the individual; confiscation happens merely based upon the arguments and evidence presented by law enforcement that an individual in question poses a threat. The fact remains that these red-flag laws create a highly problematic and dubious system rife with the potential for rampant corruption and the trampling of people's constitutional rights. The experience of gun owners in Florida largely proves it.

## The Racist History of Gun Control

The Second Amendment rally in Richmond, Virginia, was a big disappointment ... but not for those in attendance. More than 20,000 protesters marched peacefully in Virginia's capital city in support of their constitutional right to keep and bear arms.

But for members of the Leftmedia, many of whom characterized the event as an uprising of violent white nationalists, the day was a stark reminder that they just don't understand this country or its people. Satya Marar attended the gun rally, and he writes at the Washington Examiner, "While white men certainly seemed to be the majority of protesters, many other kinds of people turned up to voice their concerns about gun control as well, such as women, blacks, and members of the gay community who see their basic right to self-defense as at risk."

Of course, we're unlikely to see this sort of balanced and accurate reporting in The Washington Post or The New York Times. Thus, some Americans might be surprised that the issue of gun rights would bring together such disparate groups. But the fact that folks from across the political spectrum were united for a common cause reveals the importance of the right to self-defense, not to mention the reason why progressives are so eager to confiscate guns from millions of peaceful, law-abiding citizens.

Maybe that's why Beltway Democrats and leftists across the country have declared war on the National Rifle Association: They know that gun rights are the guarantor of all other rights and are thus the ultimate check against statism and tyranny.

While the media wants Americans to think all card-carrying members of the NRA are rural white supremacists, the organization's history proves otherwise.

"The NRA has historically opposed laws that were virtually tailor made to deny African-Americans the right to keep and bear arms," says gun writer Sam Jacobs. "Many gun control laws to this day stem from the KKK's fear of armed and independent minorities. The Rosewood Massacre in 1923 — a bloodbath led by a white mob that resulted in the destruction of an entire black community in Florida — was a clear example of how an armed black people could prevent future KKK raids."

There are countless examples, going back three centuries, of black Americans fighting against those who would oppress them. But like the slave owners of the 19th century, today's Democrat politicians would prefer that blacks remain unarmed and subservient to those in power.

"Forcibly disarming blacks in the South was among the early Ku Klux Klan's reasons for organizing and one of its first goals," David S. D'Amato writes at The Hill. "They knew what today's well-meaning advocates of gun control do not — that the black letter of the law is one thing and de facto power relations are quite another. These gun control laws were passed to disarm black citizens. We might do well to keep this history in mind today when we consider how new, more restrictive gun laws will be applied."

Not coincidentally, our nation's strictest gun-control laws tend to be in its most crime-ridden cities — cities whose inhabitants are largely non-white. Millions of inner-city blacks live in fear while being denied the right to protect themselves by the very Democrats they continually elect to office.

Maybe that's why so many blacks are now taking up arms.

"In 2015," writes Harvard history professor Tiya Miles in The New York Times, "Philip Smith founded the National African-American Gun Association in Georgia. His members, he said, are predominantly first-time gun owners and educated professionals." She adds that today's NAAGA has 75 chapters in 30 states, and Smith expects them to be "in every state within a year."

In the end, the Virginia rally might be a turning point in the perception that many Americans have of gun owners. While Democrats and the media (but we repeat ourselves) have been hell-bent on dividing people, Americans from all walks of life put politics aside and came together without a single shot being fired.


